## Explore the possibilities

Academics from the *Law Faculty of Gadjah Mada University, Indonesia*, in collaboration with academics from the *Charles Darwin University School of Law & Business*, will deliver an intensive law elective on Indonesian law from Monday 23 to Saturday 28 January 2012 at the Casuarina Campus of Charles Darwin University. Students can complete the unit in the on-campus mode, online or a combination of both.

The unit will be a broad introduction to Indonesian law including topics such as Indonesian criminal law, land law, customary law and business law. Some specialist topics in Indonesian law will also be taught in the areas of intellectual property, arbitration/ADR and the Indonesian Administrative Court. The unit code for enrolment purposes will be 'LWA211 Contemporary Issues 2'. It will be a 10 credit point (0.125EFTSL) law elective unit and may be counted as an elective in your CDU law degree (or for other degrees with your course coordinator's permission). Total contact hours (lectures and tutorials) will be 36 hours. The entire course will be conducted in English.
